

## WYLDFYRE FAQ

Q: What is WyldFyre Listings?

A: WyldFyre Listings is the latest version of the desktop software formerly known as Altaira. WyldFyre Listings will replace Altaira in March 2004.

Q: When will WyldFyre Listings be available?

A: WyldFyre Listings is now available for purchase at ABoR offices.

Q: Am I required to purchase WyldFyre?

A: No. The WyldFyre product is optional, but there is a cost for those who prefer to use a desktop product. This application can be used in addition to the Internet-based TEMPO.

Q: How much does WyldFyre Listings cost?

A: WyldFyre is available in single and office versions. MLS participants can purchase WyldFyre Listing through ABoR for \$133.96 (including tax) per copy. This product has been sold in other markets for \$299.00 or more.

Q: Will my old Altaira still work after I load WyldFyre Listings?

A: Yes. They will work independently of each other.

Q: Do I need WyldFyre & TEMPO both?

A: No. You can use either WyldFyre Listings or TEMPO to search, tax search or CMA. You will only be able to Add/Edit listings through TEMPO.

Q: What are the differences between the single user and the office versions of this product?

A: The single user version of WyldFyre Listings is designed to be used by an individual and will only recognize the owner's user name and password. The user name and preferences are embedded in the software upon installation. Single user versions can be installed on three computer systems.

The office version is designed to be installed on one computer and shared by multiple agents. The broker or the office administrator can set up a local database to manage the users and preferences associated with each. The office administrator also determines the hard disk space available for photo download as well as the length of time that individual searches are maintained on the hard disk. Users will be able to maintain their own preferences and use all of the functionality of the program except the Timed Download option that is offered in the single user version.

Q: Why should I purchase WyldFyre Listings?

A: If you prefer to work 'off-line', you will need WyldFyre Listings. You can not download information from Tempo.

Q: Is WyldFyre training mandatory?

A: No, it is not mandatory. The only training that is mandatory is Tempo. Detailed product presentations are provided at the ABoR Auditorium. For presentation dates visit [www.abor.com](http://www.abor.com).

Q: Is there a charge for MLS training?

A: No, training is free.

Q: Can my assistant take training with me?

A: Yes, assistants that have been registered with ABoR may take WyldFyre training.

Q: Will I learn about Tempo in WyldFyre training?

A: No. Tempo training is held separately. You may register for Tempo class training at [www.abor.com](http://www.abor.com).

Q: When will I be able to Add/Edit listings?

A: For now, that will still need to be done through the current system. Once we cut over to Tempo in March, you will need to Add/Edit through Tempo.

Q: If I purchase WyldFyre, must I ever access TEMPO?

A: It will be necessary to use TEMPO in 2004 if you need to add/edit listings.

Q: When will Altaira and Passport be shutdown?

A: Altaira and Passport will be terminated in March 2004.

Q: What are some benefits of WyldFyre Listings?

A: WyldFyre offers several features in addition to those offered by TEMPO. WyldFyre allows users to:

- Search listings offline after downloading the MLS/photos
- Automatically download listings and photo updates daily or hourly
- Easily customize search criteria, results and reports
- Prepare comprehensive and customized CMAs
- Access new Buyer Tours, CMA and Report Writer modules
- Access MLS data online or offline
- Use continuous Auto-Play Slide Show to showcase properties
- E-mail the listings
- Hot sheet and client updates

Q: What are the major differences between WyldFyre and Altaira?

A: WyldFyre Listings is based on newer technology and is therefore faster. WyldFyre is also being supported beyond 2004, whereas Altaira will no longer function.

Q: What are some differences between TEMPO and WyldFyre?

A: TEMPO is the complete MLS system and database which will replace Stellar. The Internet-based TEMPO system will be available at no additional cost to all members who attend mandatory training. In order to use TEMPO, you must be connected to the Internet. TEMPO is accessible by using the free Microsoft Internet Explorer and can be accessed using a PC or MAC. It does not support downloading the MLS to your computer system or searching in the absence of an Internet connection. TEMPO will be required to add/modify listings beginning in March when Altaira, Net.MLS, Passport and Stellar are permanently retired. TEMPO can be used to access the MLS from nearly

any PC with an Internet connection. TEMPO includes maps that are unavailable in WyldFyre. Property history will be available only through TEMPO.

WyldFyre supports both online and offline searches after downloading. WyldFyre Listings is not accessible with MAC systems. WyldFyre Listings does not provide an add/modify option. WyldFyre Listings may be slightly faster compared to TEMPO since the software is loaded directly on the PC and it is not necessary to send the screen shots back and forth across the Internet. WyldFyre may be significantly quicker for those who use dial-up Internet access. WyldFyre provides more e-mail options compared to TEMPO. WyldFyre provides a backup for searching in the event that TEMPO or your Internet service is interrupted.

Q: What are the requirements for WyldFyre Listings?

A: Windows 98 and higher will work. The minimum and maximum hardware specifications are as follows:
